All Township Boards, Commissions, and Committee Meetings are CANCELLED until March 30, 2020 after which time the situation will be re-evaluated for appropriate action.

All Township sponsored programs, workshops and special events are also CANCELLED until March 30, 2020 after which time the situation will be re-evaluated for appropriate action.

Please be assured that your **POLICE, FIRE & EMS RESPONDERS in Plumstead Township will be there for you! The Plumstead Township Emergency Management team have protocols in place to ensure safety of our First Responders and our residents.**
