

INVITATION TO BID

Sealed bids will be received by Plumstead Township electronically via PennBid until 11:30 AM on June 13, 2017 for pavement milling, and installation of stone subbase and bituminous paving on Silo Hill Road, a Township owned roadway. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 11:30 AM on June 13, 2017. Specifications and forms for the proposal may be obtained and/or examined on the internet at www.pennbid.net at no cost. The successful bidder is required to pay fees established by PennBid.

Bids must be made on forms furnished by the Township and must be accompanied by the anti-collusion and workmen's compensation affidavits and certified check or bid bond, issued by a surety licensed to conduct business in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in the amount of at least (10%) of the total bid price made payable to the Township. All bidders must be prequalified by PennDot as contractors.

Contract shall be subject to regulations of the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act (Act 442) as amended. A mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held on-site Tuesday, May 23, 2017 at 9:00 AM to discuss and answer any questions regarding this project. Bids will not be accepted from bidders who did not attend the pre-bid meeting.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish and pay for satisfactory insurance, and performance, payment, and maintenance bonds each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price with a corporate surety approved by the Township.

Award of contract, if a contract is awarded, will be to the lowest responsible bidder, but the Township reserves the unqualified right to reject any or all bids and waive any informalities.
