

OPERATION SAFE HOME

The Plumstead Township Fire Marshal's Office, The Plumsteadville Fire Company with the Bucks County Fire Marshal's Office are hosting "Operation Safe Home" and installing FREE smoke alarms. Availability is limited. We will begin and Focus our distribution in the Valley View Mobile Home community in Danboro. We will be in the neighborhood on Saturday, March 28, 2009 between 8:30 am and 3:00pm. We will offer to check your old smoke alarms and install new ones in your home as needed.

"Operation Safe Home" is a newly developed free smoke alarm program funded by a Federal grant. It is a partnership with Plumstead Township, Plumsteadville Fire Company, The Bucks County Fire Marshal and Bucks County Health Department's Safe Kids Coalition.

Our goal is to provide families that struggle with limited income, free ten-year lithium powered smoke alarms along with a fire safety brochure to offer them optimum safety for their loved ones. Local Firefighter from the Plumsteadville Fire Company will distribute these door-to-door, checking existing smoke alarms in your home for proper operation and install new alarms as needed.
