Ms. Sreenivasan called the meeting to order at 7:30 P.M. with a moment of silence, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Agenda: Reusable Bag Project; October 19th EAC Road Clean-up and Tree Planting; EAC participation in the Township's October 26th Halloween Event; Honoring Tom Lurz; EAC Membership.

- The reusable bags are in! Three thousand bags imprinted with sponsors logos have been received. Ms. Sreenivasan will reach out to advise the sponsors. EAC will have a table at the Township Halloween event on October 26 to hand out bags, along with pamphlets and candy. EAC is coordinating with Duane/Parks and Rec, and will ask to have the table at the beginning so children will have bags as they go around the event. Mr. Johnson and Ms. Noone will oversee the table and event which starts at 5 pm, with a 4:30 pm set up time.
- October 19, 2024 EAC Activities: 8:30 am road clean up. New EAC members need to view the safety video. A PennDOT adopt a highway safety video is available on the PennDOT site. A tree planting at Owl's Nest Park follows at 10 am. Details on the trees to come. Ms. Noone suggested adding these events to the online township calendar, Ms. Sreenivasan will ask Debbie to add.
- Honoring long time EAC member Tom Lurz: Ms. Sreenivasan will check with the township on available budget to create a memorial for Tom Lurz, in the Owl's nest lake area, one of his favorite spots. In addition, Mr. Lichtenstein advised the supervisors are working on the possibility of naming the Point Pleasant Community Park in his honor.
- Mr. Lichtenstein advised that there are three applicants being considered by the Board of Supervisors for the two vacancies on the EAC.
- Next EAC meeting will be held on the first Monday, November 4, 2024, due to election day.

Mr. Johnson moved to close the meeting; Ms. Worthington seconded.
