### POLICE EXPLORERS

The Plumstead Township Police Explorers would like to thank Chief Hasenauer for his 35 years of service. Chief Hasenauer has been a steward of community policing promoting numerous initiatives throughout his career. Seven years ago, Chief Hasenauer initiated the creation of Explorer Post 5708, in conjunction with the Boy Scouts of America, with two stated missions: (1) Honor the memory of Ofc. Joseph E. Hanusey III and (2) create a program available to the youth of the entire Central Bucks community.

On October 30, 2012 Chief Hasenauer introduced the start of Post 5708 to a room full of interested cadets and their families. He explained the designated post number was in honor of our fallen hero Ofc. Hanusey and the purpose of the program were to provide opportunities for students to gain an understanding and perspective of the various aspects of a career in law enforcement.

Through these experiences promised by Chief Hasenauer cadets have had the opportunity to feel part of the law enforcement community by providing specially designed uniforms and badges for cadets to wear to post meetings and various functions which mirror that of law enforcement. Chief Hasenauer paved the way for the cadets to be exposed to the best instructors in the area to learn firearm safety, criminal investigations, crime scene processing, accident investigations, arrest procedures, courtroom testimony as well as victim advocacy and mental health programs. Cadets have attended tours to the Buck County Court House, the adult and juvenile detention centers and



have traveled to Washington D.C. to tour the Congressional building with Congressman Brian Fitzpatrick.

With all of these experiences, Chief Hasenauer has promoted the importance of giving back to the surrounding community within the program, to which the cadets of the program have responded by completing 2,500 hours of community service and counting over the course of the program. And, if that was not enough Chief Hasenauer was instrumental in the creation of the Joseph E. Hanusey III Scholarship program which is open to cadets and students of the Central Bucks School District who aspire to earn an advanced degree in the emergency services field.

We are grateful for the leadership you provided and wish you well in retirement.

### IT'S THE LAW!

Under Section 4524 of the PA Motor Vehicle Code, you can be issued a traffic citation if your

windshield, side or rear windows are obstructed by ice or snow.

Under Section 3720 you can be issued a citation between \$200 - \$1000 if ice or snow falls from the roof of your vehicle, causing death or serious bodily injury to another motorist or pedestrian.

### A Message from the Perkasio Police Department

One unfortunate side-effect of the modern buy-everything-online lifestyle: package theft. A box or pile of boxes left sitting on your front stoop makes an easy target for "porch pirates," some of whom follow delivery trucks and scoop up packages moments after they're dropped off. This has turned into a serious problem. Nearly one third of Americans have had a package stolen from outside their home. So what can you do? The following tips may be helpful to avoid your packages taking off without you!



1. Ship to an Amazon Locker. Amazon's free service of lockers near supermarkets, convenience stores, and more
2. Ship to a FedEx Office. FedEx will hold packages at the local FedEx Office. With more than 1,900 locations, it offers a safe and convenient way to keep packages from being stolen.
3. Ship to the neighborhood grocery or drug store. If the 1,900 FedEx Office locations aren't enough, there are another 11,000-plus locations that FedEx has partnered with including more than 8,900 Walgreens and Rite Aid locations and certain Albertsons and Kroger grocery stores.
4. Send the packages to your work address. This is an easy one. If the boss will let you receive personal packages, problem solved.
5. Send the packages to a friend. If you have friends or family who you know will be home, just use their address.
6. Install an outdoor security camera. Certain security camera systems not only film but also send real-time alerts to your smartphone when the motion detector senses movement.
7. Keep your property well lit. Sometimes those porch pirates will wait until dark before they do the evil deeds. It's always a good idea to keep your property well-lit with landscape lighting. It doesn't have to be fancy or expensive. Just keep your sidewalk and porch nice and bright.
8. Make it look like you are home. This is good common sense, regardless of whether or not you're expecting a package. Lights going on and off inside a home will help keep burglars from not only stealing what's sitting on your porch, but also from breaking into your home.

### Agricultural Land Preservation An Overview

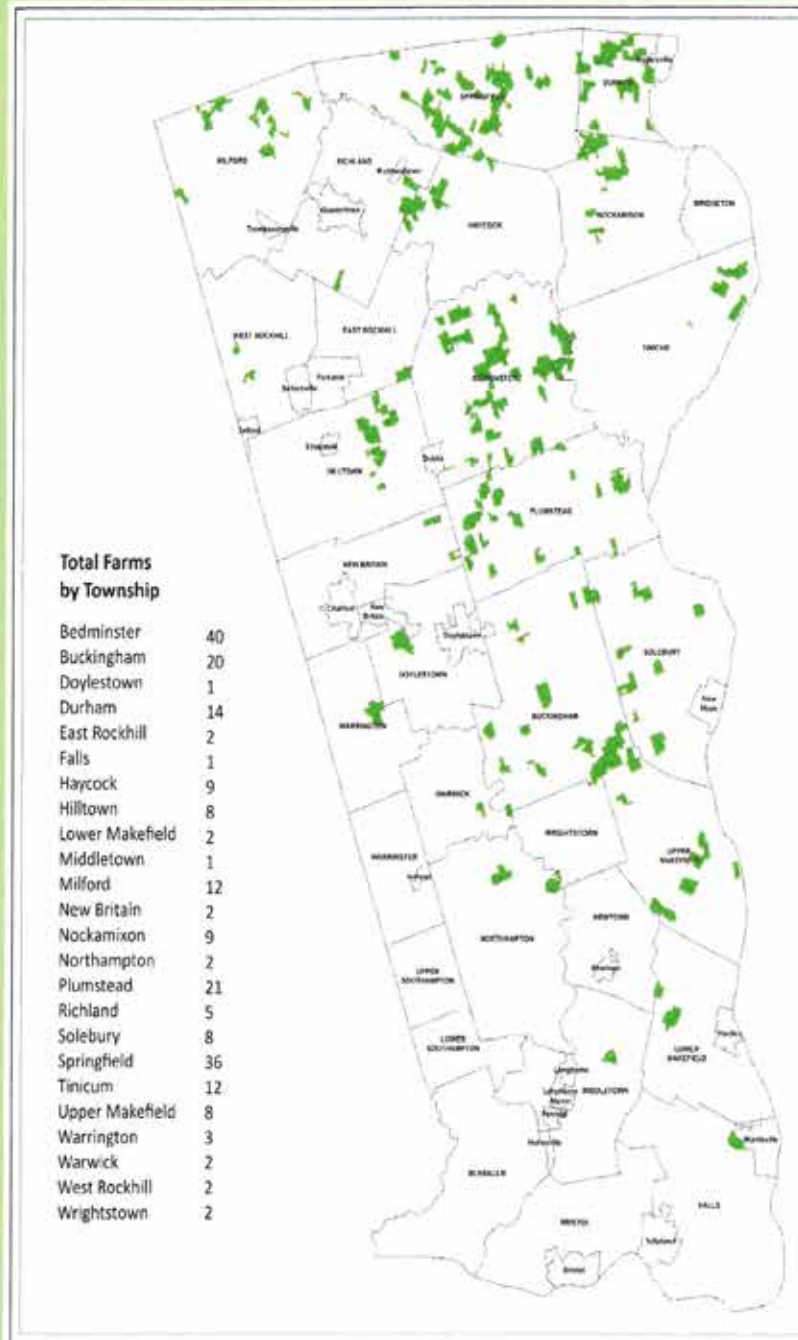
For 30 years Bucks County has been preserving family farms and prime agricultural land by acquiring agricultural conservation easements either through purchase, donation, or a combination of both. The farm owner retains ownership of the farm. Agricultural conservation easements prevent future development of the land for any purpose other than agricultural production. To date, over 17,700 acres in 24 municipalities in Bucks County are preserved with a goal to preserve a total of 18,000 acres by the end of 2019.

The value of an easement is determined by a certified real estate appraiser and is the difference between the Fair Market Value and the agricultural value of the land. In Bucks County, the cap on an easement purchase is \$12,000 per acre.

Farm owners interested in preserving their farm may submit an application to the Bucks County Agricultural Land Preservation Program at any time. Eligible farms must: be enrolled in an Agricultural Security Area of at least 500 acres; be a minimum of 50 acres unless the farm is adjacent to preserved land in which case a 10 acre minimum applies; and, contains 50 percent soils of Capability Classes I-IV which are available for agriculture. At the start of the each calendar year, applications are evaluated for eligibility and ranked using an approved numerical system. Top ranking farms are then selected for funding. The entire process to preserve a farm takes an average of 18 months.



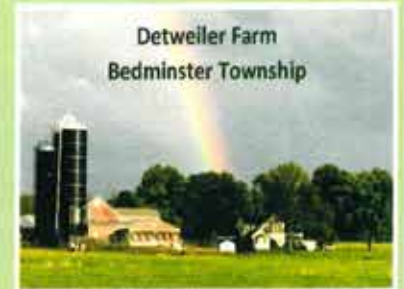
### Preserved Farms in the Bucks County Agricultural Land Preservation Program



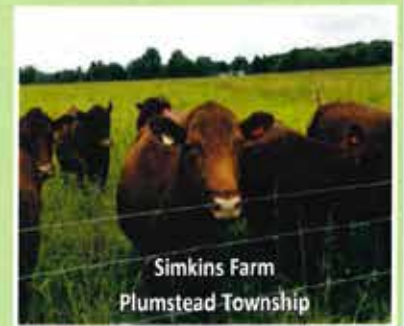
Agricultural Preservation Program

### Plumsteadville Volunteer Fire Company

#### 2020 Blaze of Glory 5k Race

For the 14th year running, The Plumsteadville Volunteer Fire Company is proud to host a community 5k road race and fun run on Saturday March 21, 2020. Our race is known as one of the biggest community events in the area. As the first race in the Bucks 5k Series ([www.Bucks5kseries.com](http://www.Bucks5kseries.com)) all proceeds from the Plumsteadville Blaze of Glory 5K will go to support the volunteer efforts of the Plumsteadville Volunteer Fire Company.

This year we are adding a fire fighter challenge, inviting fire fighters from around the area to compete against each other for bragging rights as the fastest fire company around. Would you like your kid to race a fire fighter in full gear during our fun run?

The Plumsteadville Volunteer Fire Department is staffed entirely by volunteers living in the area. We provide fire and rescue services to parts of Plumstead and Bedminster Townships as well as surrounding municipalities. Our volunteer members respond to an average of 325 emergency calls per year ranging from house fires, auto accidents/extrications, domestic rescues, brush fires, carbon monoxide and fire alarms and much more.

The budget of the Plumsteadville Volunteer Fire Company is 52% funded by Plumstead and Bedminster Townships through a dedicated fire tax. The remaining 48% of our budget is raised by our volunteer members through fundraising events and donations. Money raised goes towards much needed safety equipment, building maintenance, and replacing our aging fleet of fire trucks. For example, to outfit a single firefighter with basic safety gear will cost over \$5,500.00. This cost does not include the cost of an air pack which is an additional expense of \$6,500.00. To replace a fire truck costs between \$350,000 and \$500,000.

### Christmas Tree Safety



Christmas Tree Safety- According to the NFPA, one of every three Christmas tree fires in the home is caused by electrical problems. A heat source too close to trees causes roughly one in every four of the fires.

The NFPA recommends the following to prevent Christmas Tree Fires:

- Choose a fresh tree with green needles that do not fall when touched.
- Before placing the tree in the stand, cut 2" from the base of the trunk.
- Make sure the tree is at least three feet away from any heat source (fire place, candles, heat vents, etc.)
- Use lights appropriate for Christmas trees that give off little to no heat.
- Replace any lights with broken cords or loose bulbs.
- Read manufacturer's instructions for number of strands to connect.
- Never use lit candles to decorate the tree
- Always turn lights off before leaving the home or going to bed
