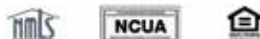

PLUMSTEAD TOWNSHIP POLICE RESIDENTIAL LOCKBOX PROGRAM



Beginning in Mid-May 2021. The Plumstead Township Police Department's residential lock box program is designed to expedite access to senior adults in their own homes during medical or other emergencies. The lockbox program also reduces the likelihood of property damaged caused by forced entry in response to an emergency call.

ELIGIBILITY

The lockbox program is open to all Plumstead Township residents who either live alone or must be left alone on a regular basis and:

- Are age 65 and above
- Are under 65, with a major medical issue that could render them incapacitated or unconscious.

HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS

- The eligible participant will complete a Lockbox Program Application to the Plumstead Township Police Department. Applications can be picked up at the front desk of the Police Department or available at Plumstead.org.
- Completed applications can be dropped off, mailed to Plumstead Police at 5186 Stump Road Pipersville, PA 18947 or emailed to Sferri@plumstead.gov
- Once the application is approved, an Officer will contact the participant and arrange to meet at the home to review the program and place lockbox.
- The participant will provide a spare house key to the Officer at which time we will place the key within the lockbox and set the code.
- The lockbox will only be used during an emergency call, and when responders cannot make entry without using force. At no time will the lockbox be used or will entry be made without authorization.
- The lockbox code will only be available to Emergency Personnel, the homeowner will not have the access code as this prevents misuse of the lockbox and they key not being returned.
- There is no cost to participate in the Lockbox Program other than the cost of the spare key.
- A participant may withdraw from the Lockbox Program at any time by contacting the Police Department at (215) 766-8741. The lockbox will be removed from the residence and the spare key returned.

Plumstead Township Police Department received a donation of Lockbox's from Wehrung's Lumber & Home Center in Ottsville, PA to begin the program.

*Apartments do not qualify for this program.

SUMMER ROAD WORK PLANNED

The following projects were submitted and approved for inclusion in the 2021 road repair and maintenance budget.

Public Works crews perform a significant amount of preparation work ahead of the final surface work.

- Windtree and Meetinghouse Estates developments – all streets
 - Inspection, repair and/or replacement of deteriorated storm inlets as needed
 - Rubberized crack sealing of asphalt cracks
 - Polymer asphalt leveling of minor defects
 - Ultra-Thin Wearing Course paving
- Cabin Run development – all streets
 - Rubberized crack sealing of asphalt cracks
- Tollgate Road, Blueberry Lane
 - Double application of liquid bituminous asphalt and stone

- Valley Park Road
 - Mill out and remove deteriorated areas and cross cracks
 - Double application of liquid bituminous asphalt and stone
- Silo Hill Road at Connector A, and Sawmill Road at Gordon Road
 - Remove and replace failing metal storm sewer pipe
- Sladek Road – portion
 - Milling and paving
- Old Easton Road, Meetinghouse Road – portions
 - 4 foot edge milling and paving
- Double Yellow Center line striping – various roads
- Engineering and design repair/rehab of the Old Easton Road stone arch culvert at Curly Hill Road

The ability for us to contact you in an emergency is required by the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection.

ANNUAL WATER QUALITY REPORT NOTICE REMINDER

Plumstead Township is required to complete an annual Consumer Confidence Report for all water system customers. The report gives basic information on the system and test results. The reports will be available online at the township website: www.plumstead.org by July 1. Click on the WATER DEPARTMENT tab and then the forms and documents tab. The reports are listed by system under 2020 Annual Drinking Water Quality Report. Printed copies can be mailed upon request by calling the Public Works office at 215-766-0189.

Homeowners Guide to Native Plants

What is a Native Plant?

The PA Native Plant Society defines a native plant as “one that occurs naturally in a particular region, ecosystem, or habitat without direct or indirect human intervention.”

Why Native Plants?

Native Plants are adapted to growing in locations in which they live, making them less susceptible to challenging conditions. Planting with Natives has many benefits such as:

- Low Maintenance - Native plants are adjusted to the soil, climate, and rainfall of their regions.
- Color - Plants native to this region offer year-round colors that change seasonally.
- Fewer Pesticides - Because Natives have thrived in the same environment as local pests, they have adapted and can tolerate pests and even attract beneficial insects.
- Conserve Water - Native plants conserve water because they have adapted to the local rainfall and may require less watering.
- Support Wildlife - Bird and pollinators rely on trees, shrubs and other plants as their source of food and habitat. Native plants rely on the pollen, fruit, and seeds that these plants produce as well as the insects they support. When you plant with Natives, you are providing a dependable food source for your local wildlife.
