

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-06
A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF
PLUMSTEADTOWNSHIP, BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
APPROVING THE APPOINTMENT OF A DEPUTY TAX
COLLECTOR PURSUANT TO THE LOCAL
TAX COLLECTION LAW

WHEREAS, Plumstead Township (the "Township") is a Second-Class Township organized and operating under the Pennsylvania Second Class Township Code; and

WHEREAS, the Township has an elected Tax Collector, whose office and authority are governed by the Local Tax Collection Law, 72 P.S. §§5511.1-5511.42; and

WHEREAS, the Local Tax Collection Law allows an elected Tax Collector to appoint one or more Deputy Tax Collectors, subject to the approval of the governing body of the municipality and the Tax Collector's surety; and

WHEREAS, the elected Tax Collector of Plumstead Township has requested approval of the appointment of a Deputy Tax Collector to assist in the performance of statutory tax collection duties; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to act in full compliance with the Local Tax Collection Law and applicable auditing, bonding, and accountability requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Plumstead Township, Bucks County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

1. The Board of Supervisors hereby approves the appointment of Nicole Percetti as Deputy Tax Collector for Plumstead Township, as selected and appointed by the elected Tax Collector, in accordance with Section 22 of the Local Tax Collection Law. 72 P.S. §5511.22.
2. The Deputy Tax Collector shall perform such duties as are delegated by the elected Tax Collector and permitted under the Local Tax Collection Law. The Deputy Tax Collector shall act solely under the authority and supervision of the elected Tax Collector and shall not be deemed an employee or officer of the Township.
3. The appointment of the Deputy Tax Collector shall be effective upon satisfaction of all bonding and qualification requirements and shall continue at the pleasure of the elected Tax Collector, unless sooner revoked or terminated in accordance with law.

4. The Deputy Tax Collector shall be properly bonded and approved by the Tax Collector's surety in addition to the approval by the Township, prior to performing any duties involving the collection or custody of public funds.


5. Any compensation to be paid to the Deputy Tax Collector shall be determined by the elected Tax Collector and approved by the Board of Supervisors, consistent with the Local Tax Collection Law and applicable Township resolutions or fee schedules.

6. The Chair of the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to execute any agreement or acknowledgment required to effectuate this Resolution. The Township Manager is authorized to execute such administrative documents only if expressly directed by separate Board action and solely to implement the approval granted herein.


7. If any provision of this Resolution is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining provisions, which shall remain in full force and effect.

8. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.






